CRITICAL OPERATIONAL ITEMS FOR POOLS

The licensee shall not operate a public swimming pool or portion thereof when an imminent health hazard is present, including but not limited to the following:

- 1. A covering for any main drain or other suction outlet that is not properly installed, securely fastened or in compliance with the requirements within ANSI/ASME A 112.19.8-2007;
- 2. A safety vacuum release system that is not functioning:
- 3. When the disinfection residual is less than what is required in accordance with paragraph (D)(6) of this rule.
- 4. When the circulation and/or disinfection system is not operating properly.
- 5. An automatic chemical controller that is not functioning in accordance with paragraph (D) (7) of this rule.
- 6. When lifeguard is not provided as required in paragraph € (4) of this rule.
- 7. Water clarity that is insufficient to clearly see a Secchi disc or a drain outlet cover at the bottom of a public swimming pool.
- 8. Natural or artificial light that is not sufficient to see the bottom of a public swimming pool.
- 9. When fecal accident occurs until it has been properly treated in accordance with the procedures in Appendix A of this rule.
- 10. When a recreational waterborne illness is linked to a public swimming pool wither by a current epidemiological investigation or positive water sample results until it has been properly treated in accordance with the procedures in Appendix A of this rule.
- 11. The improper or unauthorized use or storage of chemicals that may present an imminent health hazard to patrons or staff; or
- 12. When an electrical hazard may exist at a public swimming pool in accordance with paragraph (S) (3) of rule 3701-31-05.1 of the Administrative Code.
